BONESCRN (PI)

- 2. Quantitative computed tomography (QCT)
- 3. Calcaneal ultrasonography
- 4. Other
- 98. Patient refused bone mineral density screening

OSTEOTX (PI)

Was the patient on medication to prevent or treat osteopenia or osteoporosis?

- 1. Bisphosphonate (Alendronate) (Risedronate)
- 2. Serum estrogen receptor modulator (SERM) (Raloxifene)
- 3. Parathyroid hormone (Calcitonin, Teriparatide)
- 4. Hormone therapy (estrogen)

BMDTDT (PI)

Enter the date of the patient's most recent bone mineral density test.

OSTXDT (PI)

Enter the treatment start date.
