

BRIEFINTV (Global Measures)

Following the positive screening result for alcohol use, did the patient receive a brief intervention prior to discharge?

- 1. The patient received a brief intervention including all of the following components
 - Concern that the patient is drinking at unhealthy levels known to increase his/her risk of alcohol-related health problems
 - b. Feedback linking alcohol use and health, including:
 - Personalized feedback (i.e., explaining how alcohol use an interact with patient's medical concerns [hypertension, depression/anxiety, insomnia, injury, congestive heart failure (CHF), diabetes mellitus (DM), breast cancer risk, interactions with medications])
 OR
 - General feedback on health risks associated with drinking.
 - Advice to abstain (if there are contraindications to drinking)

 OR

Advice to drink below recommended limits (specified for patient).

- 98. Patient refused/declined brief intervention
- 99. Brief intervention was not offered to the patient during the hospital stay or unable to determine if a brief intervention was provided from medical record documentation
