MEDRECDT (HBPC)

MDE = Missing or Invalid Data Exclusion (data error)

NEWMEDRX (HBPC)

During the HBPC encounter on (computer to display medrecdt) when medication reconciliation was performed, was a new medication prescribed, added or identified during the medication reconciliation process?

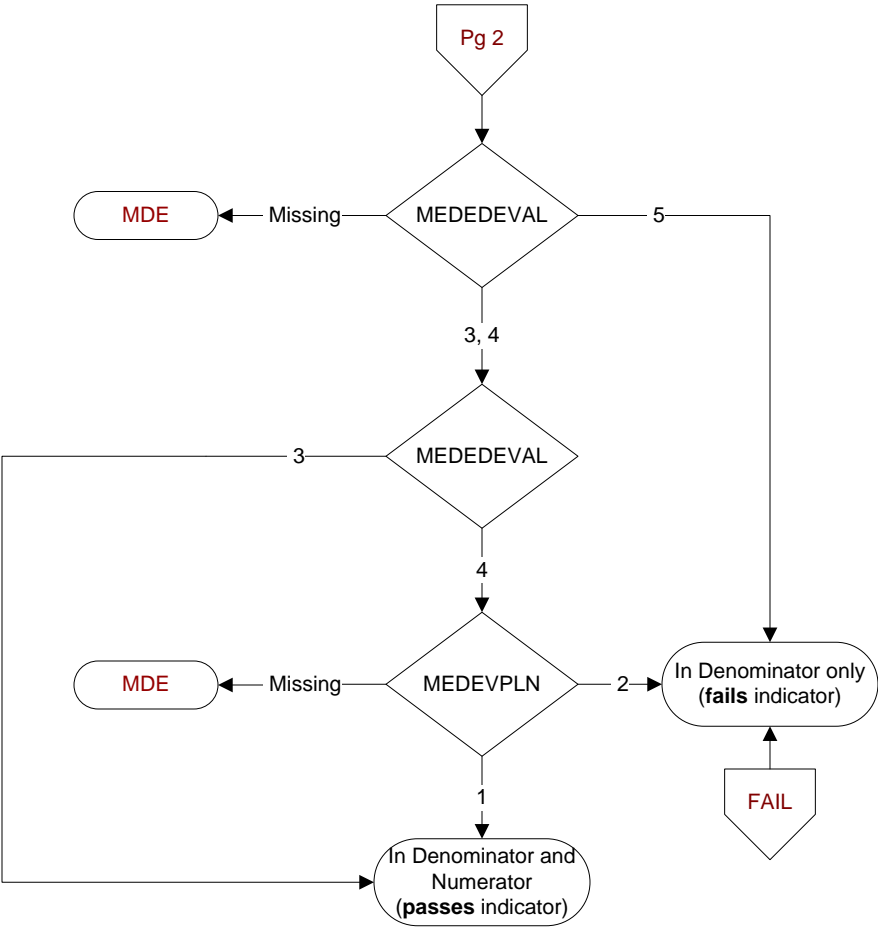
NOEDPLN (HBPC)
