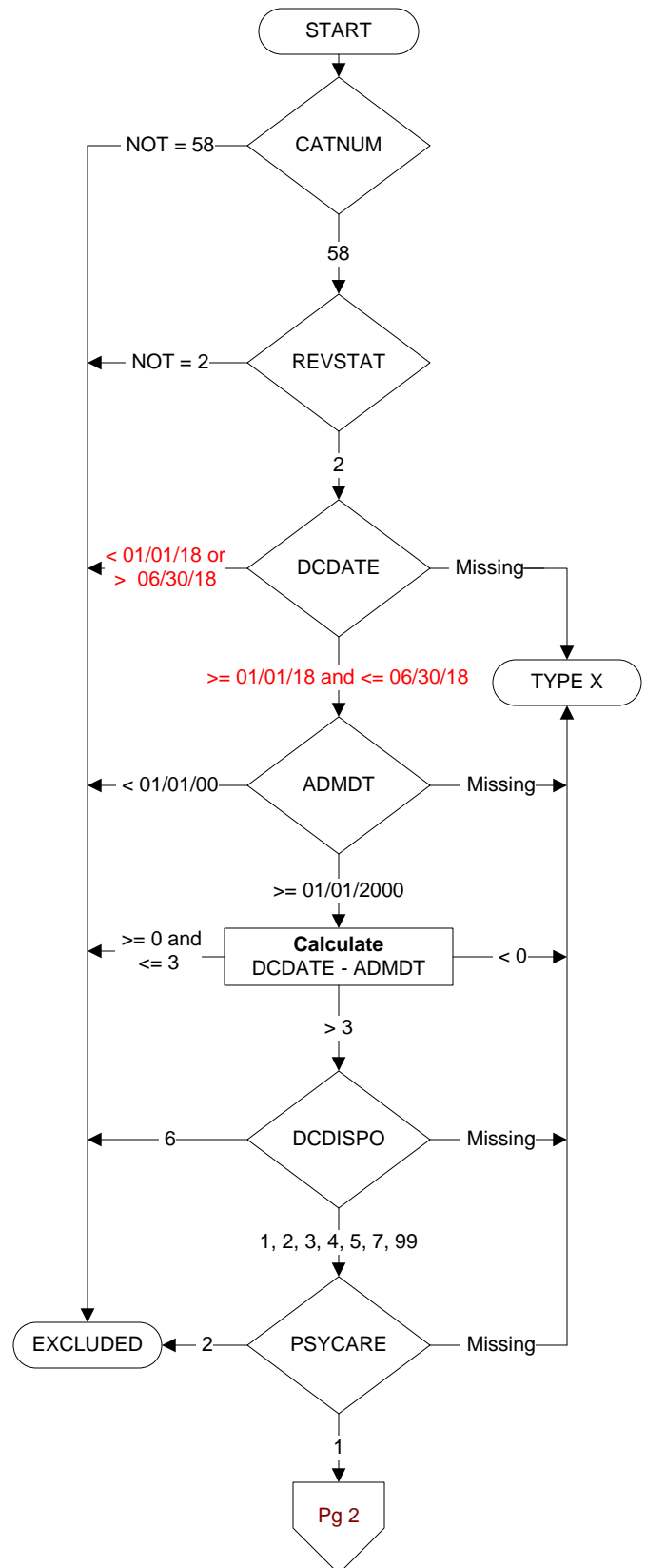

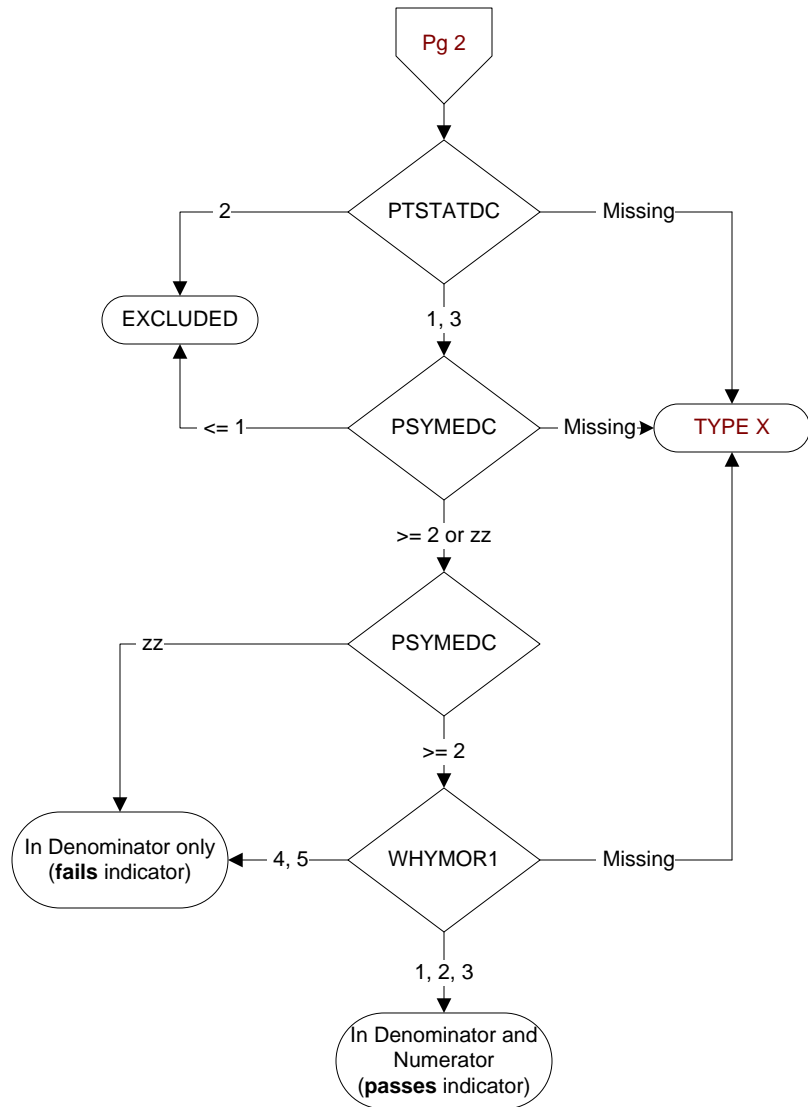

What was the patient's discharge disposition on the day of discharge?  
1. Home  
- Assisted Living Facilities (ALFs) – includes assisted living care at nursing home/facility  
- Court/Law Enforcement – includes detention facilities, jails, and prison  
- Home – includes board and care, domiciliary, foster or residential care, group or personal care homes, retirement communities, and homeless shelters  
- Home with Home Health Services  
- Outpatient Services including outpatient procedures at another hospital, outpatient Chemical Dependency Programs and Partial Hospitalization  
2. Hospice – Home (or other home setting as listed in #1 above)  
3. Hospice – Health Care Facility  
- General Inpatient and Respite, Residential and Skilled Facilities, and Other Health Care Facilities  
4. Acute Care Facility  
- Acute Short Term General and Critical Access Hospitals  
- Cancer and Children's Hospitals  
- Department of Defense and Veteran's Administration Hospitals

### PTSTATDC

What was the patient's status at the time the patient left the hospital based inpatient psychiatric care setting?

- The medical record contains documentation that the patient was discharged from the hospital based inpatient psychiatric care setting under these circumstances:
  - Patient is leaving the psychiatric unit within the acute care hospital AND the hospital facility completely.
- The medical record contains documentation of one of the following:
  - the patient eloped and was discharged
  - the patient failed to return from leave and was discharged
  - the patient has not yet been discharged from the hospital
  - the patient was transferred/discharged from the inpatient psychiatric unit in an acute care setting to another level of care (i.e. medical unit) and subsequently discharged from that level of care
- Unable to determine from medical record documentation

### PSYMEDC

Enter the documented number of scheduled antipsychotic medications prescribed for the patient at discharge.

### WHYMOR1

Is there documentation in the medical record of appropriate justification for discharging the patient on two or more routine antipsychotic medications?

- The medical record contains documentation of a history of a minimum of three failed multiple trials of monotherapy
- The medical record contains documentation of a recommended plan to taper to monotherapy due to previous use of multiple antipsychotic medications **OR** documentation of a cross-taper in progress at the time of discharge
- The medical record contains documentation of augmentation of Clozapine
- Documentation of a justification other than those listed in options 1 – 3
- The medical record does not contain documentation supporting the reason for being discharged on two or more antipsychotic medications **OR** unable to determine from medical record documentation
