





**AMIDCDT (CVD)**

Enter the discharge date from the most recent hospitalization for acute myocardial infarction during the past 2 years.

**FRSTDCDT (CVD)**

Enter the date of the discharge associated with the first episode of AMI within the last 18 months.

**BB6MOS (CVD)**

Is there documentation in the medical record the patient was on a beta-blocker continuously during the timeframe from (computer to display most recent of amidcdt or frstdcdt + 179 days)?

Examples of beta-blockers include, but are not limited to:

- metoprolol succinate or tartrate
- carvedilol
- atenolol
- nadolol
- propranolol
- combination of beta-blockers with other drugs

**RSNOBETA (CVD)**

On (computer to display most recent of amidcdt or frstdcdt), does the record document any of the following reasons for not prescribing a beta-blocker?

1. Beta-blocker allergy
2. Bradycardia (heart rate less than 60 bpm)
