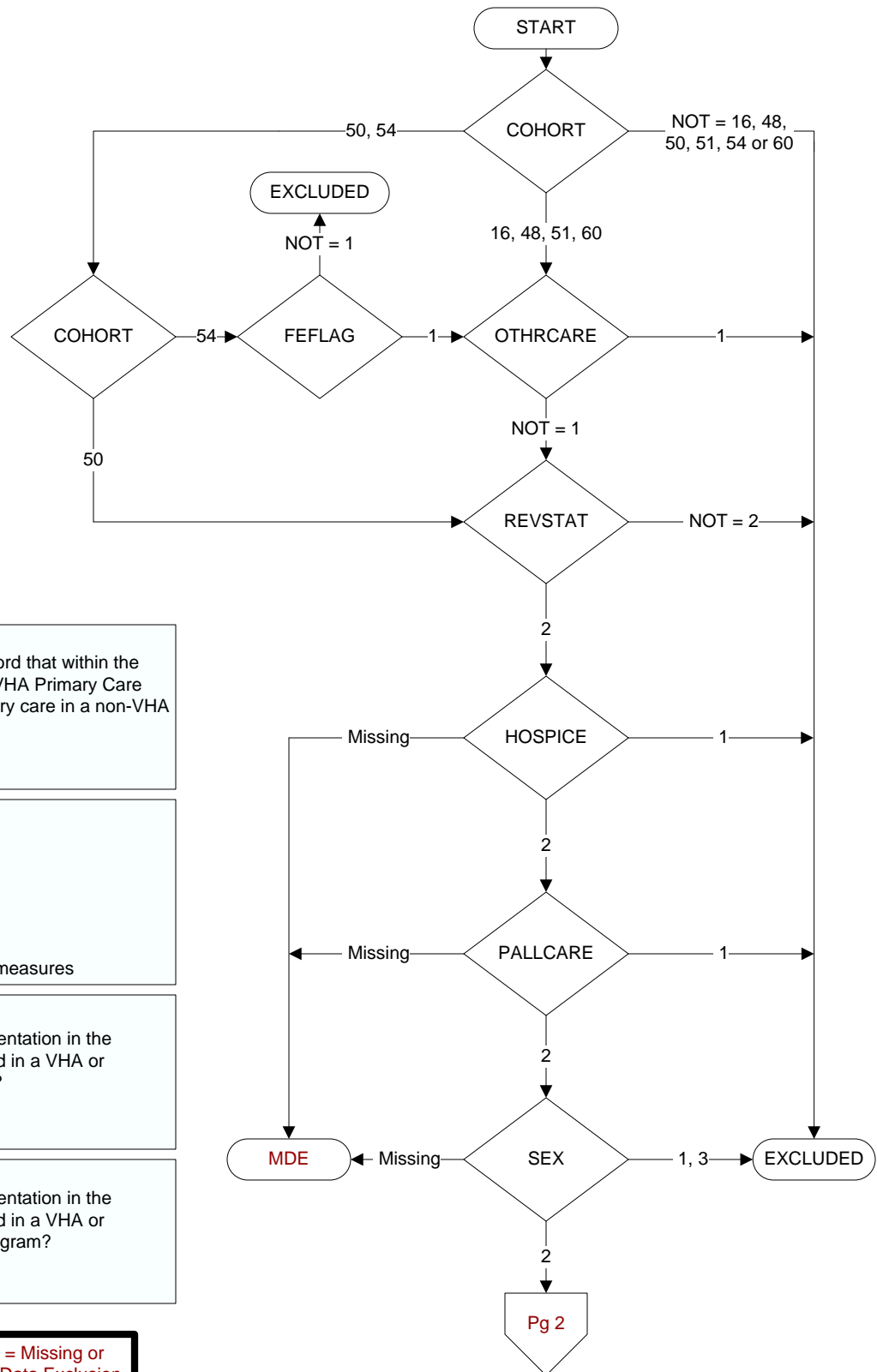

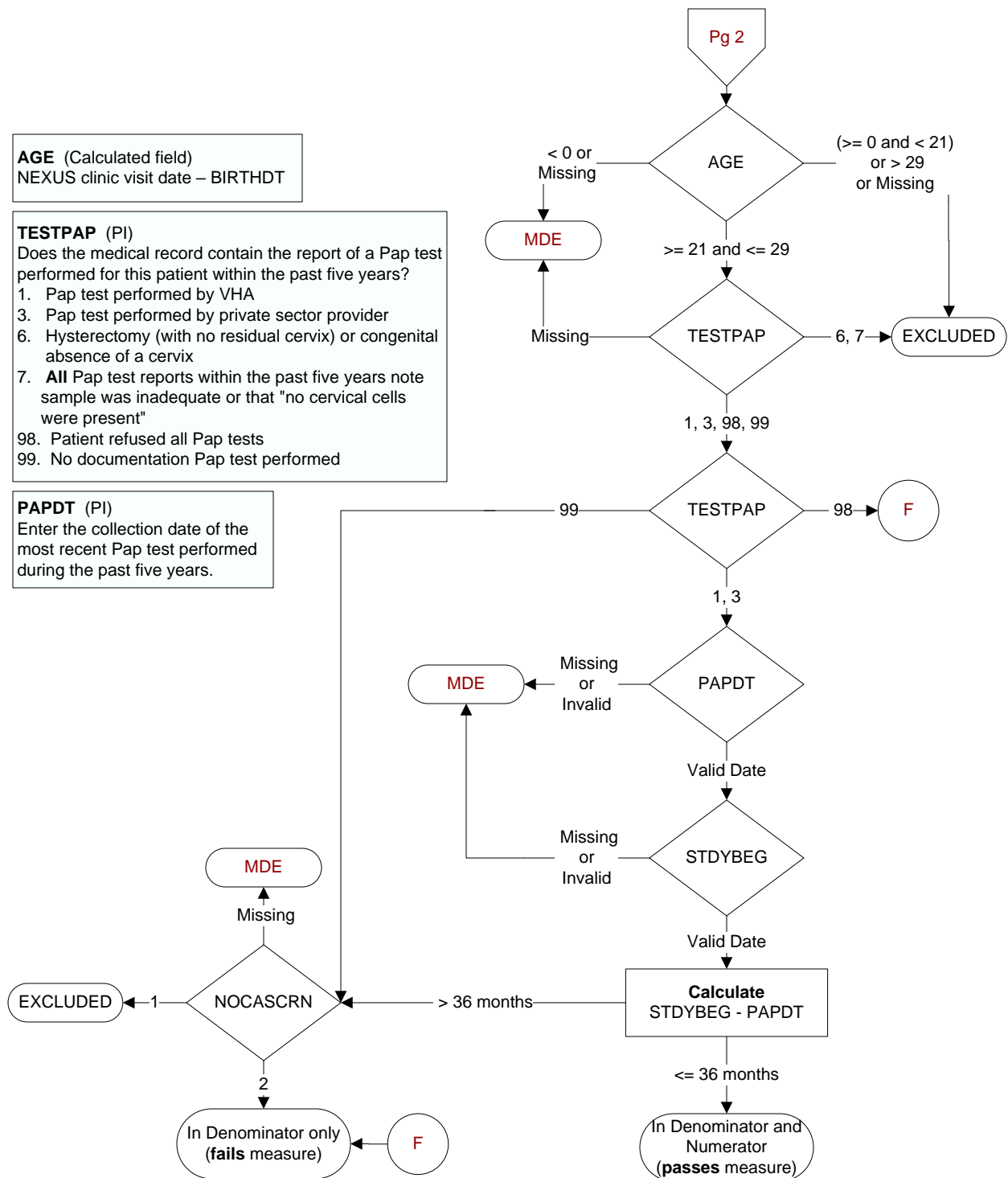
TESTPAP (PI)

Does the medical record contain the report of a Pap test performed for this patient within the past five years?

1. Pap test performed by VHA
3. Pap test performed by private sector provider
6. Hysterectomy (with no residual cervix) or congenital absence of a cervix
7. **All** Pap test reports within the past five years note sample was inadequate or that "no cervical cells were present"
98. Patient refused all Pap tests
99. No documentation Pap test performed

PAPDT (PI)

Enter the collection date of the most recent Pap test performed during the past five years.

**NOCASCNR** (PI)

During the past five years, did the patient's primary care physician/APN/PA document that he/she does not believe that this patient will experience a net-benefit from cancer screening (breast or cervical), because of one or both of the following:

- Patient's life expectancy is < 5 years because of diagnoses or clinical factors (as specified in the progress note)
