



**AUDITC** (Global Measures)

Was the patient screened for alcohol misuse with the AUDIT-C within the first day of admission (by end of Day 1)?

1. Yes

2. No

97. The patient was not screened for alcohol use within the first day of admission (by end of Day 1) because of cognitive impairment

98. Patient refused screening for alcohol misuse within the first day of admission (by end of Day 1)

ALCSCOR (Global Measures)

Enter the total AUDIT-C score documented within the first day of admission.

BRIEFINTV (Global Measures)

Following the positive screening result for alcohol use, did the patient receive a brief intervention prior to discharge?

1. The patient received a brief intervention including all of the following components

- Concern that the patient is drinking at unhealthy levels known to increase his/her risk of alcohol-related health problems
- Feedback linking alcohol use and health, including:
 - Personalized feedback (i.e., explaining how alcohol use can interact with patient's medical concerns [hypertension, depression/anxiety, insomnia, injury, congestive heart failure (CHF), diabetes mellitus (DM), breast cancer risk, interactions with medications])

OR

- General feedback on health risks associated with drinking.

c. Advice to abstain (if there are contraindications to drinking)

OR

Advice to drink below recommended limits (specified for patient).

98. Patient refused/declined brief intervention

99. Brief intervention was not offered to the patient during the hospital stay or unable to determine if a brief intervention was provided from medical record documentation
