**REVSTAT**  
REVIEW STATUS (not abstracted)  
0. Abstraction has not begun  
1. Abstraction in progress  
2. Abstraction completed w/o errors  
3. TVG failure (exclusion)  
4. Record contains missing required answers  
5. Administrative Exclusion

**MEDRECDT** (HBPC)  
Enter the date of the most recent HBPC face to face or telephone encounter when medication reconciliation was performed by a physician/ APN/PA, pharmacist, RN, or LPN during the past 90 days

**MDE = Missing or Invalid Data Exclusion (data error)**

**NEWMEDRX** (HBPC)  
During the HBPC encounter on (computer to display medrecdt) when medication reconciliation was performed, was a new medication prescribed, added or identified during the medication reconciliation process?  
1. Yes

**MEDEDCON1-4** (HBPC)  
During the time frame (computer to display medrecdt – 10 days to medrecdt + 10 days), did a physician/APN/PA, pharmacist, RN, LPN, or \*Registered Dietician (RD) provide education on the new medication(s) prescribed/added to the patient/caregiver to include:




